CANNING THORACIC INSTITUTE EXPANDS INNOVATIVE TREATMENTS



Northwestern Medicine launched the [DREAM \(Double Lung Replacement and Multidisciplinary Care\) program](#) in March after the second successful transplant for patients with late-stage lung cancer. Dr. Bharat and the team removed both cancerous lungs and replaced them with healthy lungs, reducing the risk of cancer cells contaminating the new organ or other body parts.

CELEBRATING COLLABORATION WITH LURIE CANCER CENTER

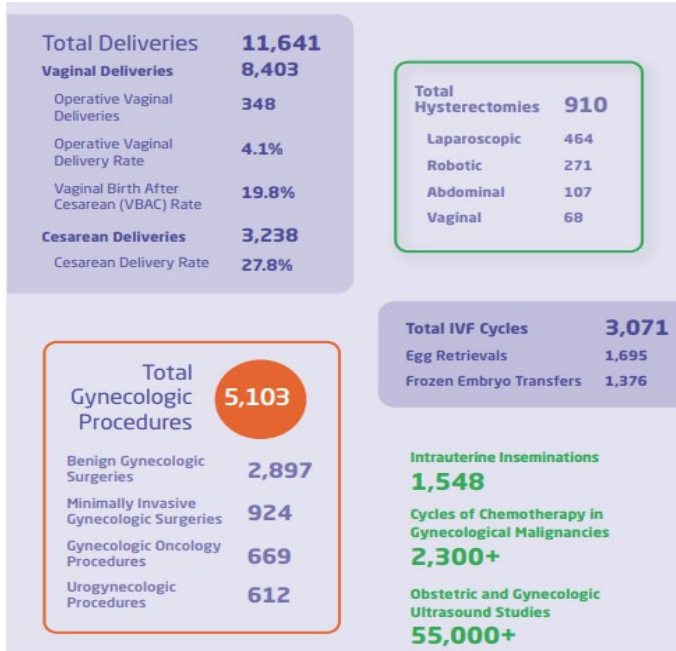

NM also offers targeted programs such as the [Cardio-Oncology Program](#) to support patients through every step of their oncology journey and life in remission.

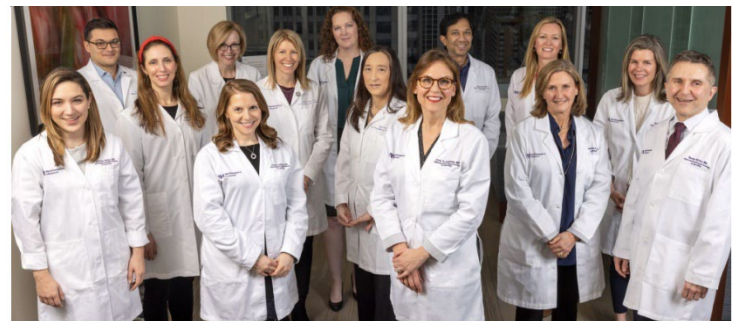


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A YEAR IN REVIEW WITH OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY
